Declaration of Conformance concerning Conflict Minerals from the DRC

Energy Access Inc. would like to inform you about an important development in US law and the new requirements it will impose on our suppliers and their supply chains.


The Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, also known as the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (the Act), includes requirements under Section 1502 for manufacturers of products that contain tantalum, tungsten, tin or gold (collectively “known as “3TG”), to identify minerals in their products that come from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or any of its adjoining countries and to file certain reports with the SEC.

This new law reflects the growing concern about the funding of armed conflict in the eastern DRC that comes from the mining and transport of these four minerals. This Act seeks to address some of these concerns by requiring more transparency in supply chains.

Please be advised that Energy Access Inc. is taking immediate action to implement the controls necessary to respond to the reporting requirements, supplier engagement and the 3TG mineral tracing process. Energy Access Inc. does not purchase these metals directly from the smelters or mines, so we rely on source information from our suppliers using the standardized **EICC/GeSI Conflict Minerals Reporting Template**. This form is used to trace the metals back through the supply chain to find the source of the supplier.

Energy Access Inc. supports this initiative by requesting suppliers to source metals from the listed smelters that are validated as a conflict free smelter (as these list become available).
